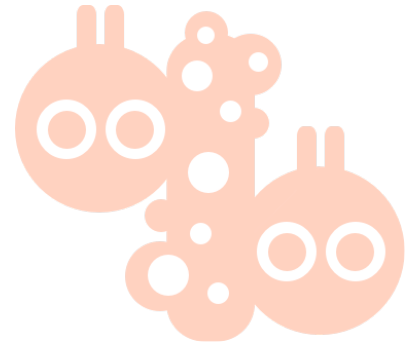

EDUCATION TECHNOLOGY: CARES ACT FUNDING

<p>Governors Emergency Education Relief</p>	<p>Distributed to Governors who can then grant these funds to K12 districts and colleges most significantly impacted by COVID-19.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fund educational services, either directly or through third parties.• Support the ongoing functionality of the district.
<p>Education Stabilization Funding</p>	<p>Distributed to Districts based on Title 1 allocation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Purchasing Educational Technology (hardware, software, connectivity) aiding in the regular and substantive education interactions between students and instructors.• Provide technology for virtual instruction for all students.• Funding for providing online learning for summer session and/or supplemental after school programs.• Assistive technology or adaptive equipment to address needs of at-risk students (low-income, minorities, students with disabilities, English learners).
<p>Rural Development Program</p>	<p>Distributed by the Department of Agriculture for rural areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Funding for telemedicine• Funding for distance learning services
