EDUCATION TECHNOLOGY: FEDERAL FUNDS

Title I	School-wide funding to upgrade entire educational programs, including distance learning <ul style="list-style-type: none">CARES ACT WAIVER - waives the requirement of 40%+ low-income children in order to allow Targeted Assistance programs to changed to school-wide programs.
Title I – 1003a	Funds for evidence-based interventions that have helped or will improve student outcomes via comprehensive and/or targeted support
Title II	Can be easily used for Education Technology by rolling 100% of funding over into Title IV
Title III	Education technology for English Learners
Title IV	Funding for Education Technology that promotes personalized learning, hardware, digital learning resources and professional development related to technology <ul style="list-style-type: none">CARES ACT WAIVER - removes the 15% cap on Ed Tech spending and the 20% minimum spend on well-rounded, safe & healthy student requirements
Comprehensive Literary Development Grant	Can be easily used for Education Technology by rolling 100% of funding over into Title IV
21st Century Community Learning Center Grant	Competitive Grant providing k12 children in low-performing schools programs before or after school. For Summer 2020 funding for online learning is available if campuses are closed
